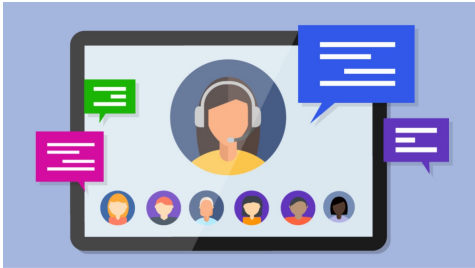
Today, enjoy reading about **Wendy Doyal, City Clerk, City of**
