Open Government Sunset Review Questionnaires

In 2018, the Legislature created a public record exemption in s. 119.071(1)(g), F.S., for United States Census Bureau address information – including maps showing structure location points, agency records that verify addresses, and agency records that identify address errors or omissions – held by an agency pursuant to the Local Update of Census Addresses (LUCA) Program authorized under federal law. This public record exemption stands repealed on

October 2, 2023, unless reviewed and reenacted by the Legislature under the Open Government Sunset Review Act (s. 119.15, F.S.).

**Security and Firesafety Systems/Plans
and Certain Structural Information Questionnaire**



The House Government Operations Subcommittee, the Senate Committee on Banking and Insurance, and the Senate Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability are conducting a review, under the Open Government Sunset Review Act (s. 119.15, F.S.), of the following public record and public meeting exemptions related to security and fire safety systems/plans and records that depict the internal layout or structural elements of specified facilities, complexes,

or developments:

- Section 119.071(3)(a), F.S.
- Section 119.071(3)(c), F.S.
- Section 281.301(1), F.S.
- Section 286.0113(1), F.S.

As part of the review, a questionnaire has been drafted. The questionnaire has three sections corresponding to the different exemptions (some sections cover more than one exemption).

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) Will Open Application Window for Broadband Opportunity Program on November 2

Dear Broadband Stakeholders,

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) is preparing to open the application window for the Broadband Opportunity Program, a \$400 million grant program created to expand broadband Internet service in unserved areas of the state. On September 28, 2022, DEO's Office of Broadband submitted its notice of proposed rulemaking to the Florida Administrative Register and commenced the 30-day online posting of application and scoring materials required in Section 288.9962, F.S., on www.FloridaJobs.org/Broadband.

Beginning on November 2, 2022, the 30-day application window for the Broadband Opportunity Program will open. The last day to submit a grant application will be at 5:00 PM Eastern Standard Time (EST) on December 2, 2022. [Read More](#)
