PUBLIC NOTICE SCHEDULE

Notice of Election:
(100.021 FS)

Published twice during 30 days prior to qualifying in a newspaper of general circulation or on website.

Precinct Change:
(101.71 (2) FS)

Published in a newspaper of general circulation or on website no more than 30 days or fewer than 7 days prior to Election Day and mailed to each voter or voters' household at least 14 days prior to Election Day.

Sample Ballot:
(101.20 (2) FS)

Mailed to each voter or voters' household at least 7 days prior to the election if not published in a newspaper of general circulation prior to Election Day.

Logic & Accuracy testing:
(101.5612 (2) FS)

At least 48 hours prior to Logic & Accuracy testing, public notice shall be posted in a newspaper of general circulation and on the website.

Logic & Accuracy Canvassing Board Members:
(102.141 (1) FS)

Post the names of Canvassing Board members on website upon completion of the logic & accuracy test.

Canvass Board Meeting:
(102.141(2)(b) FS)

At least 48 hours prior to meetings, the time, place and Canvassing Board members' & alternates' names shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation, posted on website, and on entrance door.

Election Certification Meeting:
(102.141 (2)(b) FS)

At least 48 hours prior to meetings, the time, place and Canvassing Board members' & alternates' names shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation, posted on website, and on entrance door.

Voting System Audit:
(101.591 (3) FS)
(Rule 1S-5.026)

At least 24 hours prior, the date, time, and place of the post-election audit including the random selection of the race(s) and precinct(s) shall be posted in four conspicuous places, on entrance door and the home page of the website.
