200 bags.

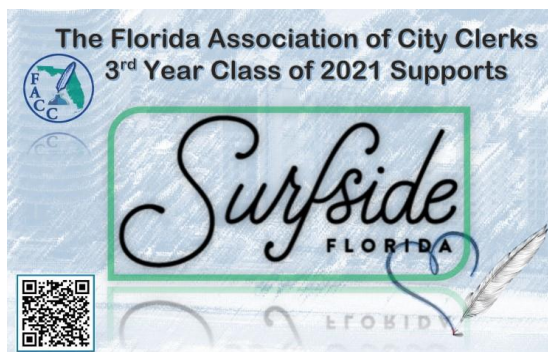
