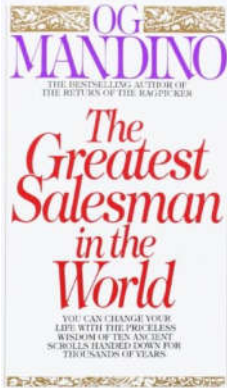

This Athenian Dialogue discusses the book “The Greatest Salesman in the World” by Augustine “Og” A. Mandino.

From the most widely read inspirational and self-help author Og Mandino, “The Greatest Salesman in the World” is a tiny book that serves as a guide to enduring life-changing secrets of success. Expanding on a short story the author had written for a motivational magazine, this book tells the story of Hafid, a poor camel boy who achieves a life of abundance. A parable set in the time period just prior to Christianity, “The Greatest Salesman in the World” weaves mythology with spirituality into a much-needed message of inspiration in this culture of self-promotion. The author believes that to be a good salesperson (i.e., Municipal Clerk) you must believe in yourself and the work you are doing. It is a simple but profound spiritual philosophy about how to succeed in the world's marketplace. The book is easy to understand and easy to take to heart.

***This Athenian Dialogue has been pre-approved for three IIMC CMC or MMC education points with the satisfactory, timely completion of a learning assessment. All participants must have completed the book in its entirety as a prerequisite for dialogue attendance.**

IIMC Region III Director - Florida



Florida will be in line in May 2024 to have a representative as an International Institute of Municipal Clerks (IIMC) Region III Director. Region III covers five states: Alabama, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Please visit IIMC's [website](#) to view Director Qualifications, the Nomination Form, the Candidates Guide and other information pertinent to the position, should you wish to nominate yourself for consideration. Please note that should there be more than one nominee from Florida, an election will be held by IIMC and all of the Region III members will

vote. Nominations must be received by IIMC no later than 120 days prior to the IIMC annual meeting held in May 2024. This is a three-year commitment.

The FACC Board of Directors has approved up to \$2,500 per year (for three years) expense reimbursement to financially assist the Florida representative with travel expenses for those meetings where expenses are not covered by IIMC and/or the Florida representative's municipality. To receive this expense reimbursement assistance, the Florida representative must be an FACC member in good standing and meet all other criteria as put forth by IIMC and FACC (see appropriate policies.)

Meetings an IIMC Region III Director would attend include but are not limited to and are subject to change:

February/March: IIMC Region III Meeting

May: IIMC Annual Conference (hotel is covered for Thursday/Friday by IIMC)

June: FACC Summer Conference and Academy (FACC covers room and registration for all Region III Directors)

August: North Carolina Association of Municipal Clerks Annual Conference (complimentary registration)

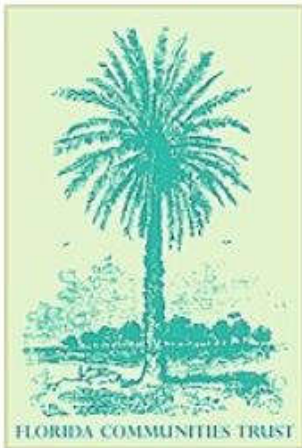
October: South Carolina Association of Municipal Clerks Annual Conference (complimentary registration)

November: IIMC Mid-Year Board of Directors Meeting (All expenses covered by IIMC by reimbursement)

Florida Communities Trust Grant Application Opens Soon



The Department of Environmental Protection announced the grant application cycle for the Florida Communities Trust (FCT) [Parks and Open Space Florida Forever Grant Program](#) will be October 10, 2023 - January 10, 2024. Last Session, \$15 million was appropriated for FCT grants, to local governments and land conservation organizations, for acquisition of community-based parks, open space and greenways that further outdoor recreation and natural resource protection needs. On September 14, FCT staff will host a webinar to inform interested parties of this grant funding opportunity and the application and project selection process.
